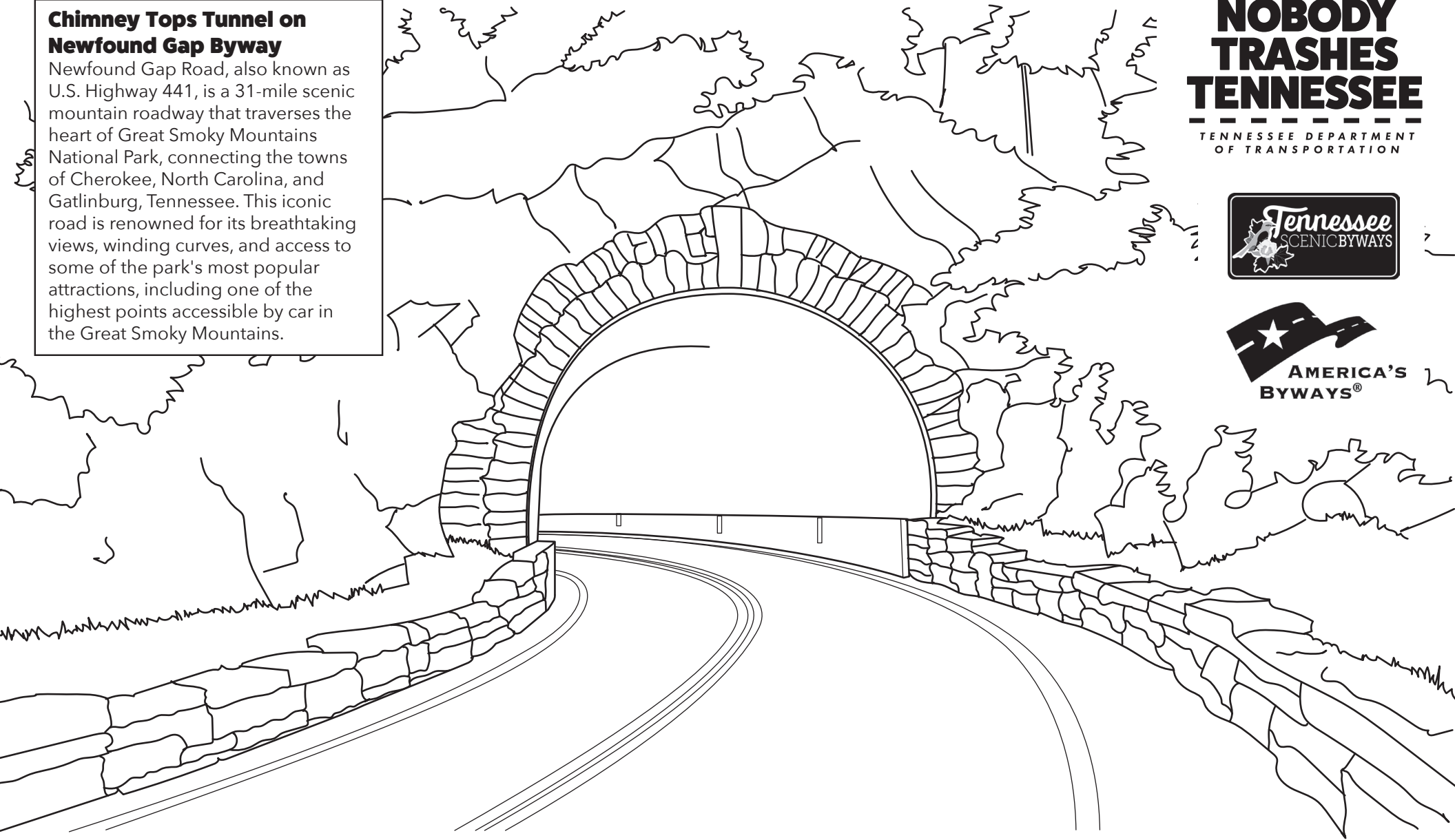


Chimney Tops Tunnel on Newfound Gap Byway
